




New England - Snowfall





Boston - February Snowfall



- Snowiest February on record
- · February: all-time snowiest month
 - 6th snowiest January on record
- Jan.-Feb. 2015 is the snowiest 2-month period

Boston - Season Snowfall

Accumulated Snowfall - Boston Area, MA (ThreadEx)



- 3rd snowiest season (Oct.-May)
 - Snowiest winter (Dec.-Feb.)
 - 2015: 2nd snowiest year


Boston - Snowfall Stats

- 3rd greatest 1-day snowfall (22.1" on Jan. 27)
- Greatest 7-day, 10day, 14-day, 30-day snowfalls
- This season has the greatest number of 12"+ snowfalls (4)





Worcester - February Snowfall




- Snowiest February on record

- January is the 5th snowiest month
- · Jan.-Feb. is the snowiest 2-month period

- 5th snowiest season (Oct.-May)
- Greatest 1-day, 7-day, 10-day, 14-day, 30-day snowfalls



Providence, RI:


- 5th snowiest Jan.

New England - Snow Depth




Boston's greatest snow depth on record: 37" on Feb. 9*
