

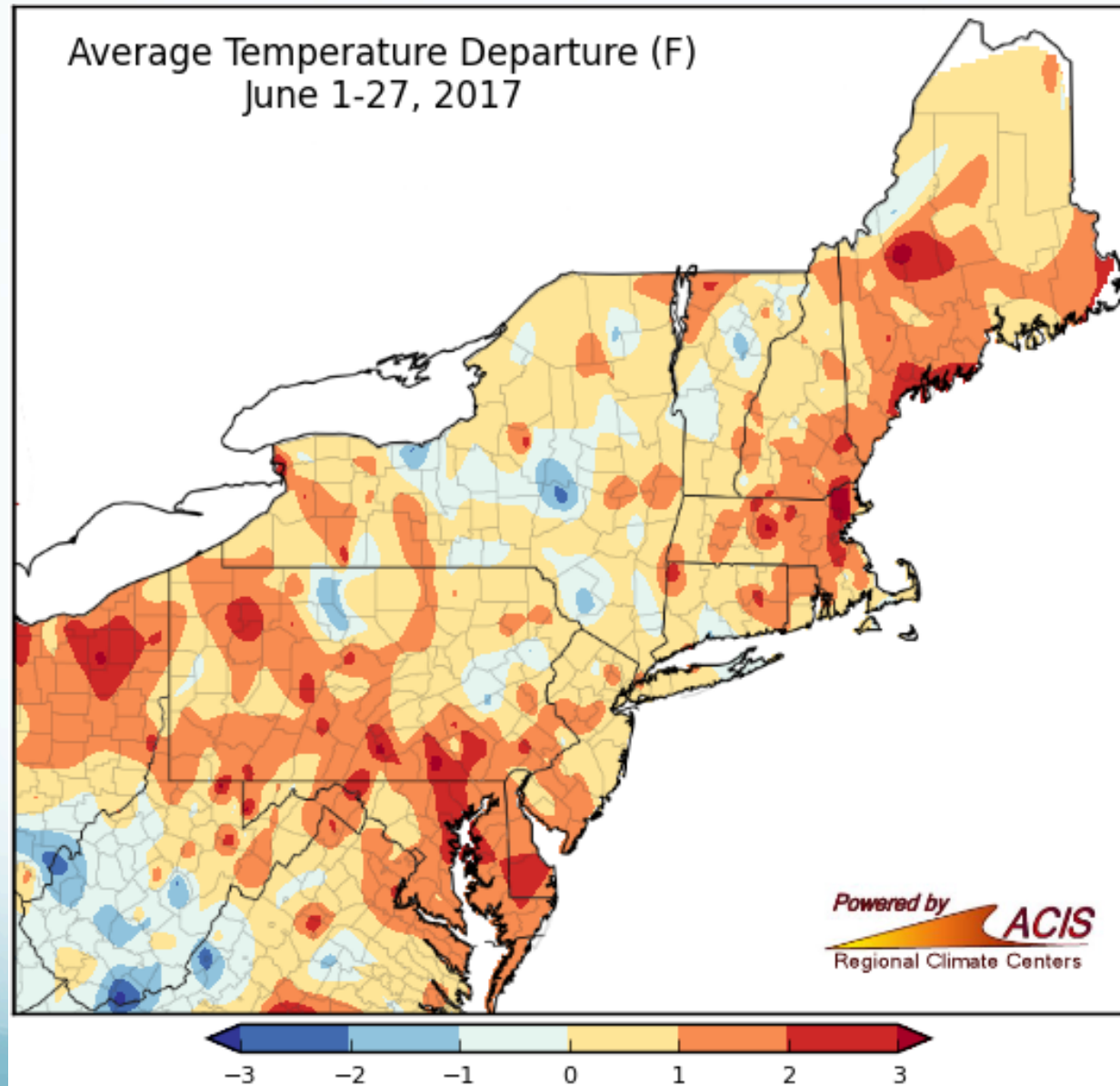

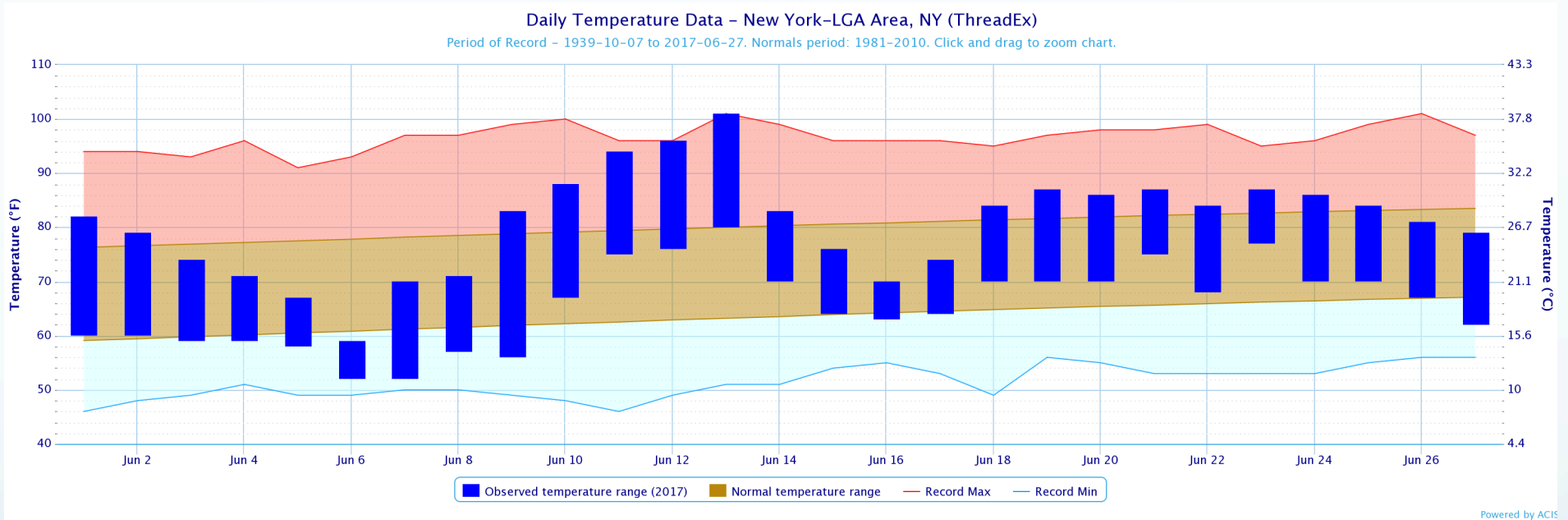

From 2°F below normal to 3°F above normal

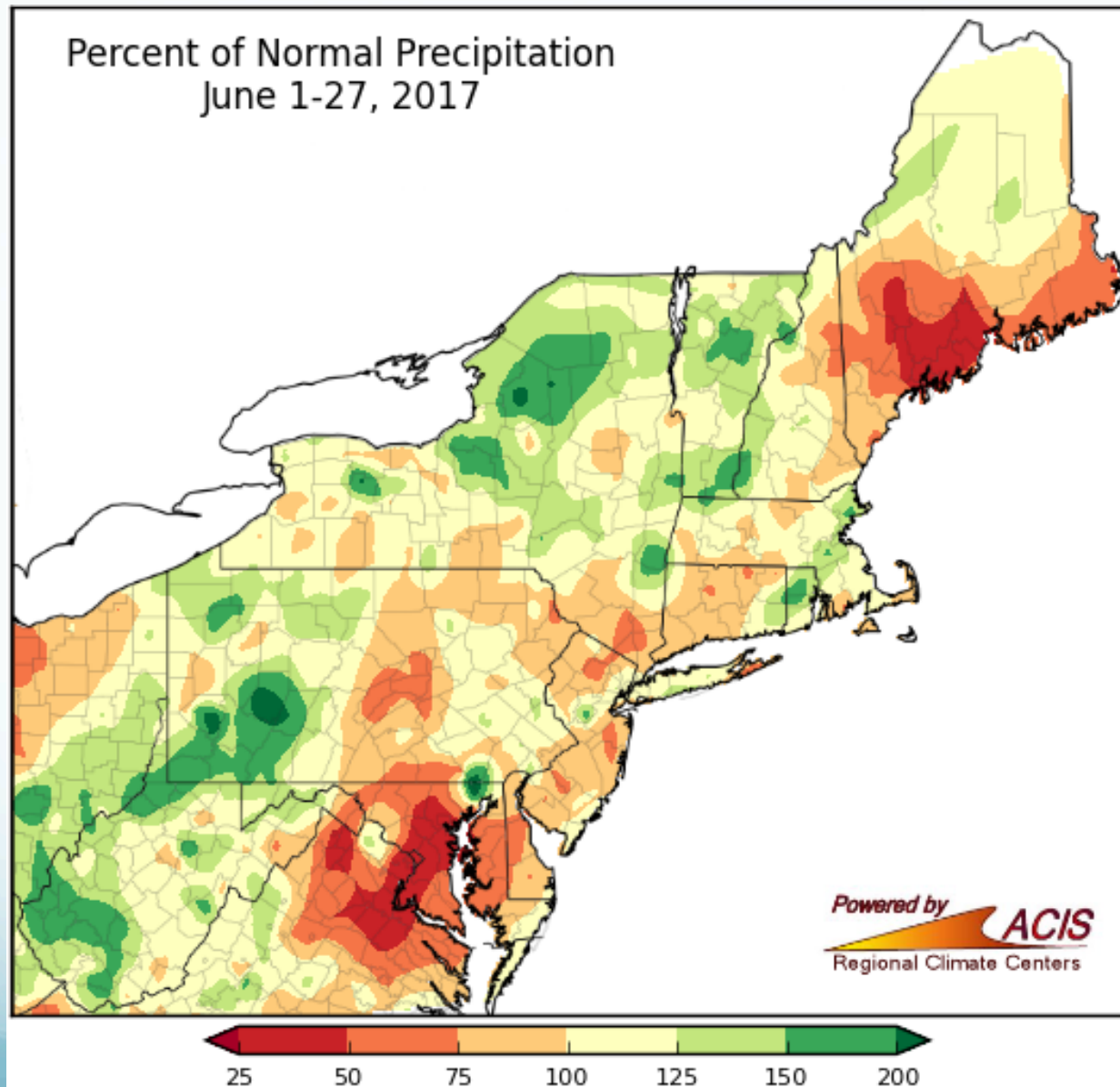
June Temperatures

June Precipitation



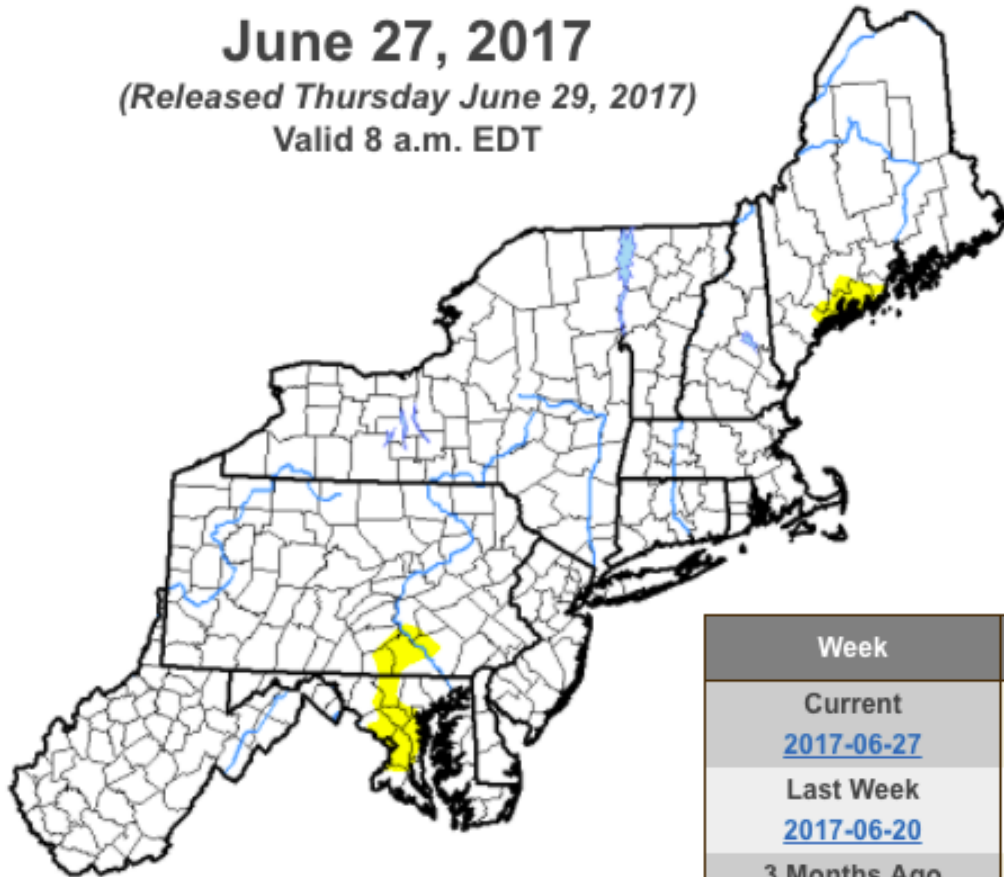
From 25% of normal to 200% of normal

Intensity:

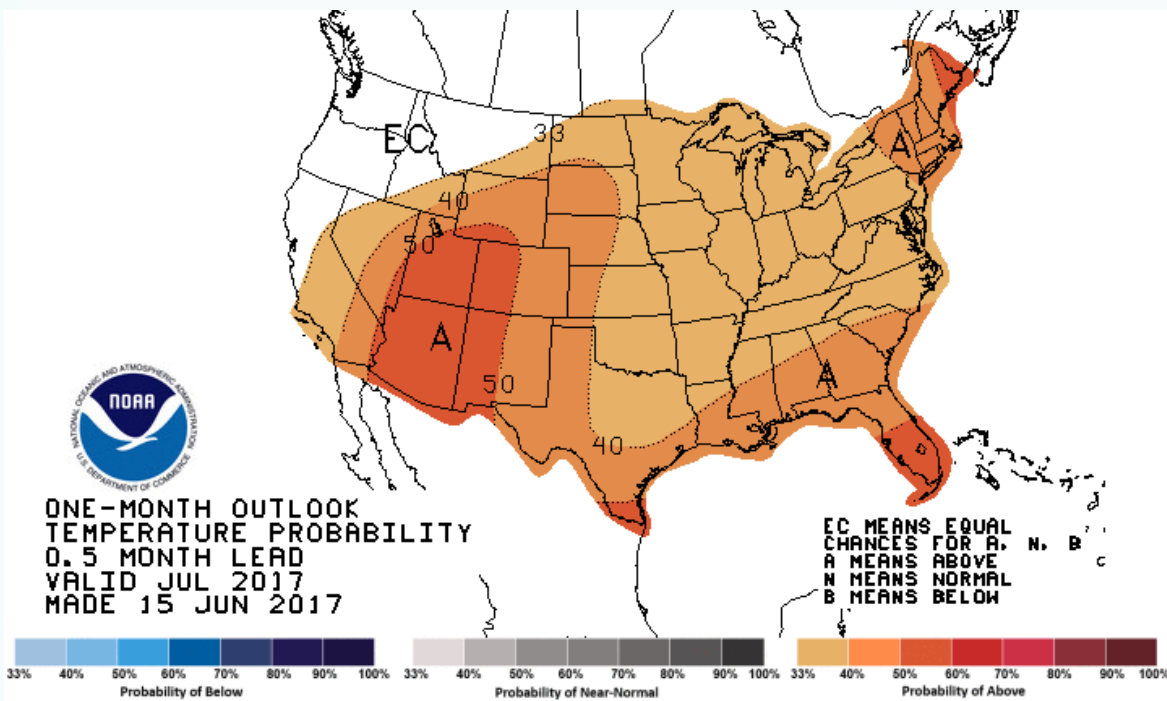
- D0 Abnormally Dry

Some abnormally dry areas

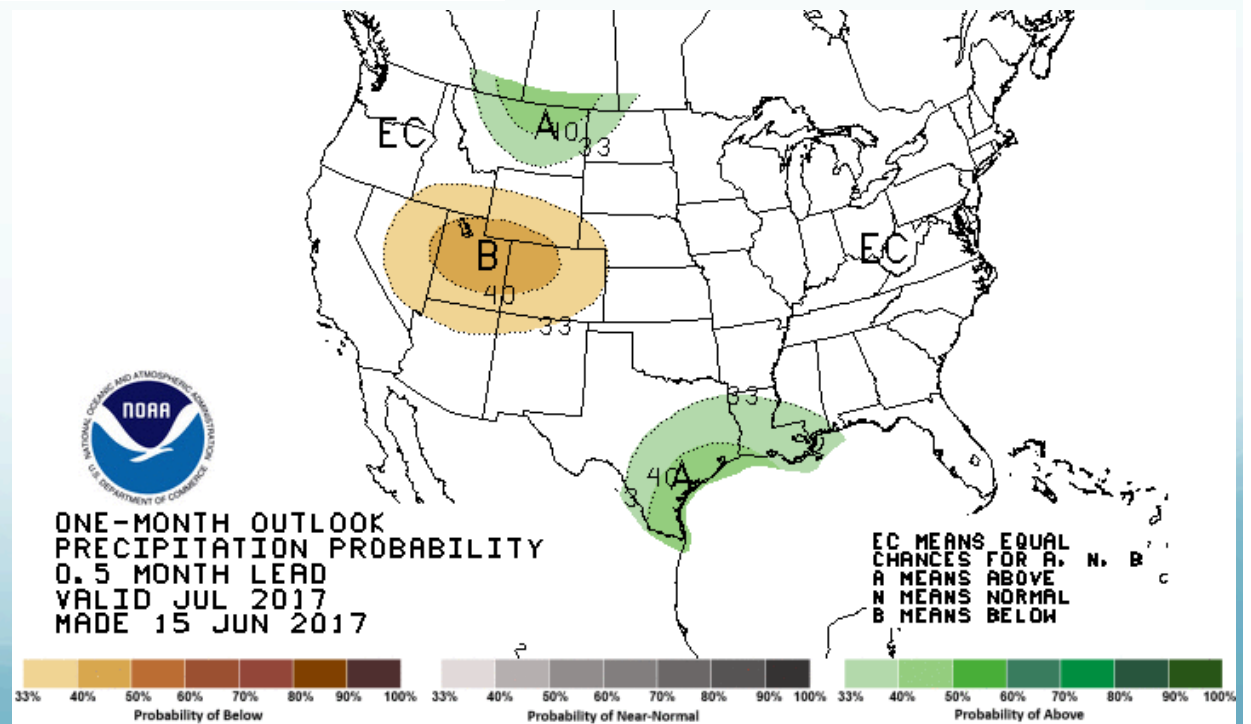
