



From 4°F below normal to 6°F above normal


## **April Precipitation**










March 30: 9% of the region was in a drought 28% was abnormally dry


April 27: 14% of the region was in a drought 41% was abnormally dry




## Standardized Precip Index






#### Soil Moisture

Calculated Soil Moisture Ranking Percentile APR 27, 2021




