


From 2°F below normal to 4°F above normal

Coolest areas generally south & west:

- West Virginia
- Parts of PA, MD, western NY

Warmest areas generally north & east:

- New England
- Eastern NY
- Parts of NJ



Local Temperatures


- Greatest number of consecutive days of 80°F+

- Min temp of 68°F+ 3 times this Aug, has only happened 3 other times








From less than 50% of normal to more than 150%
