

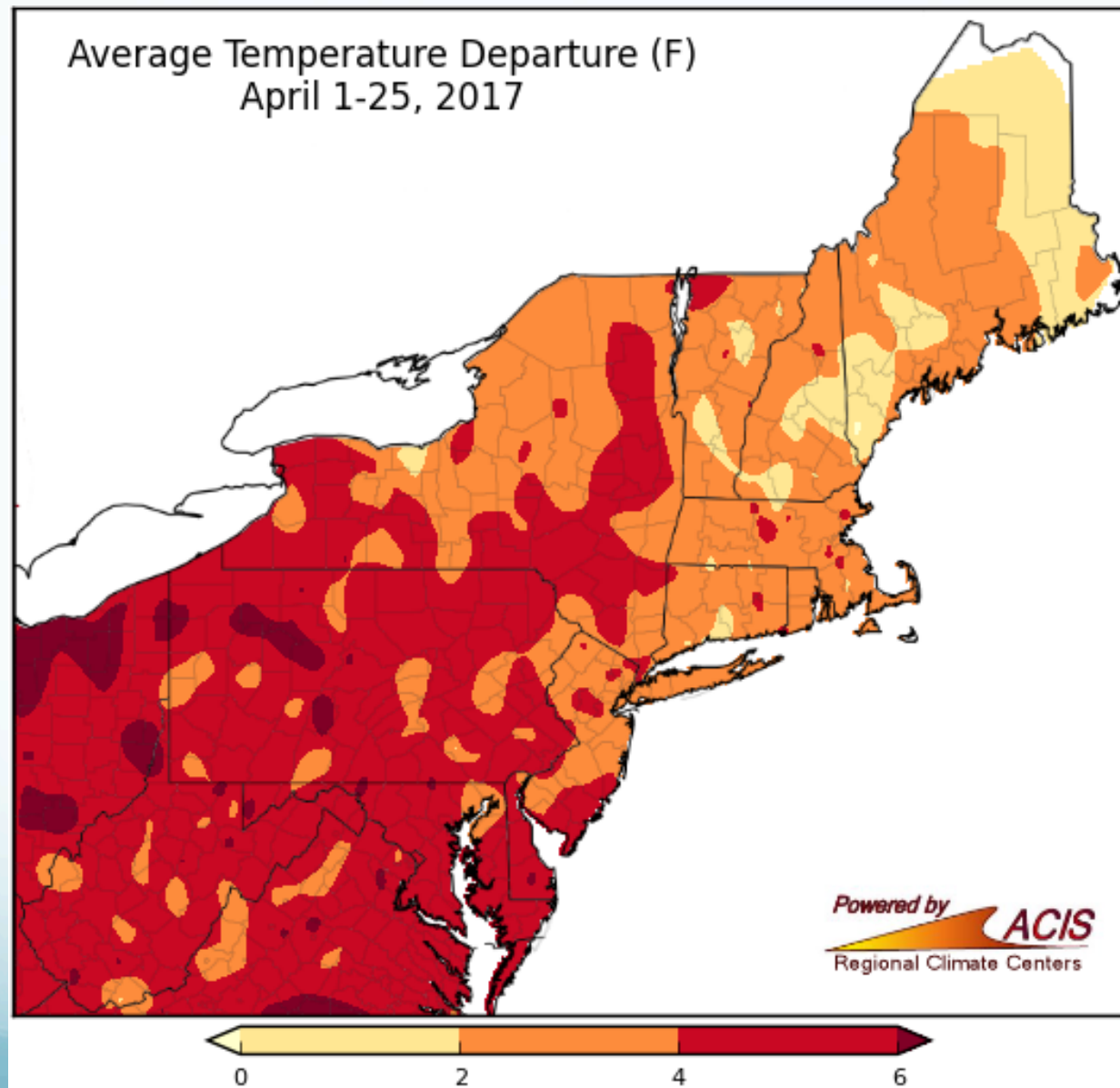

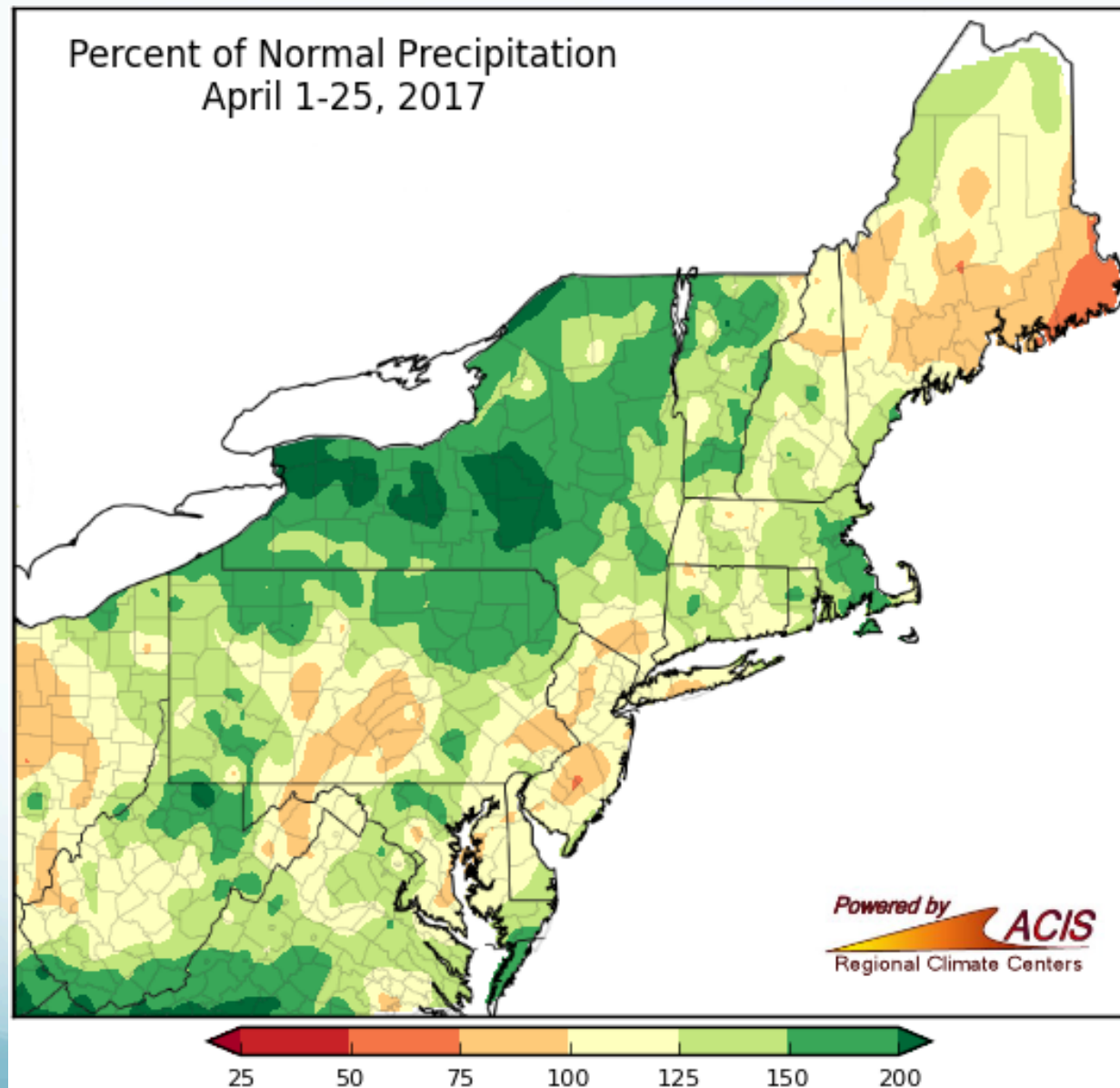

April Temperatures



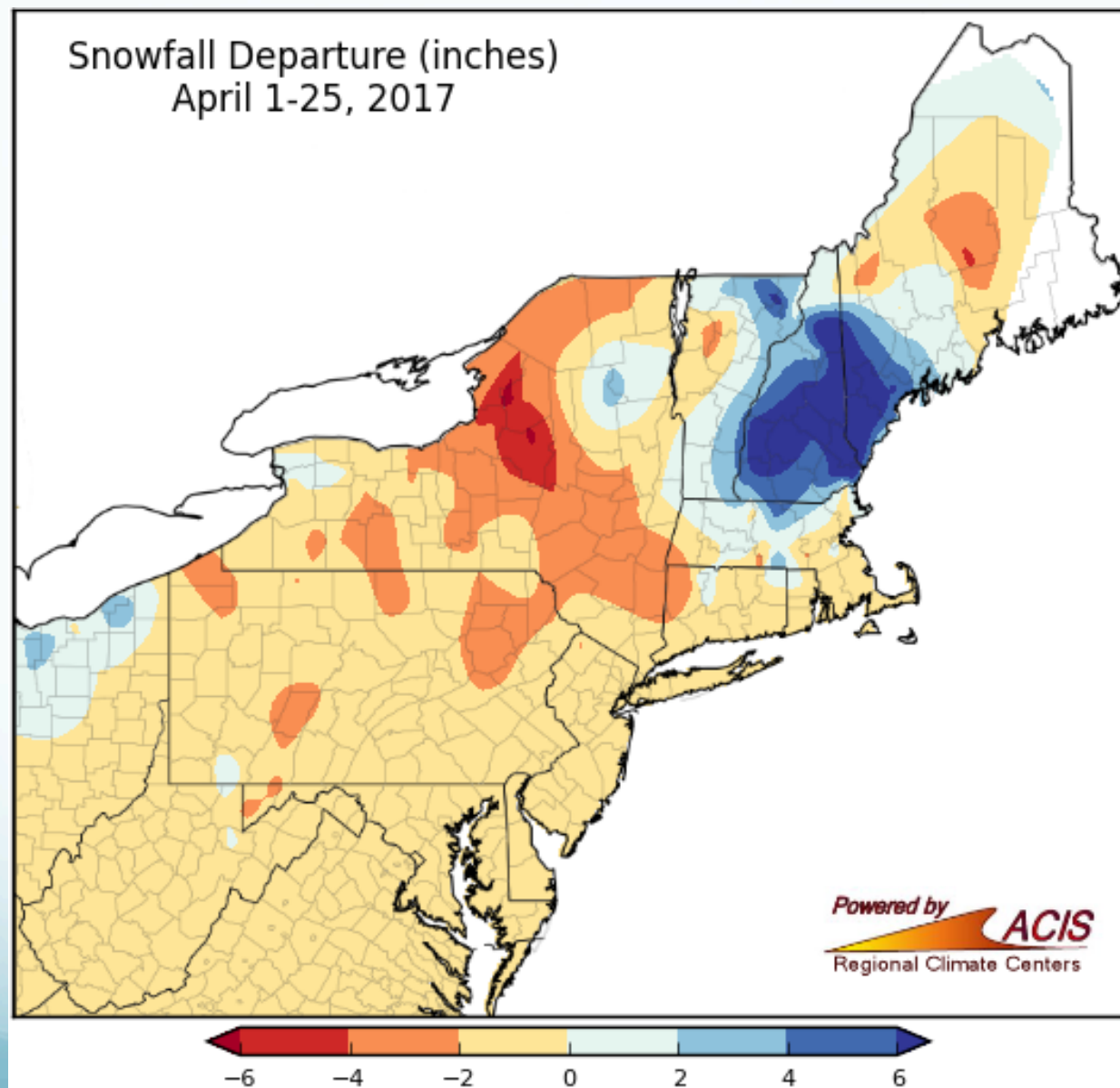
From near normal to more than 6°F above normal

April Precipitation



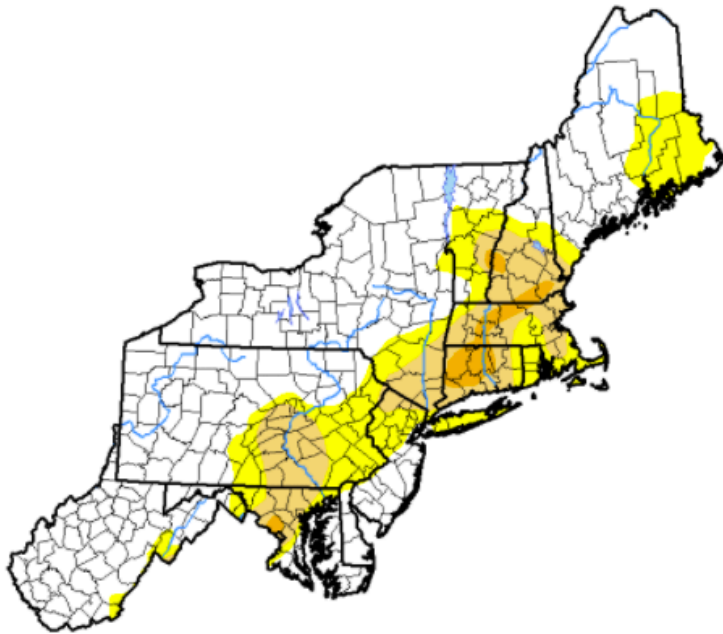
From 50% of normal to more than 200% of normal

April Snowfall

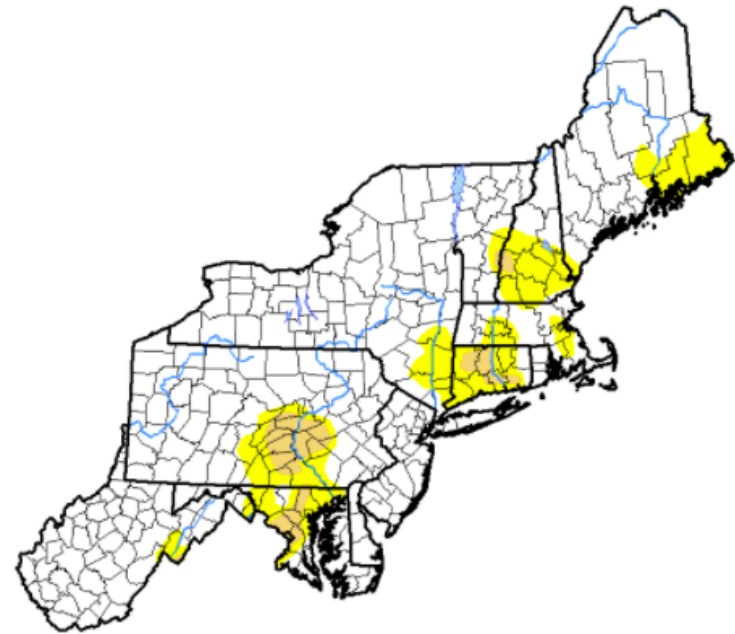


From 6" below normal to more than 6" above normal

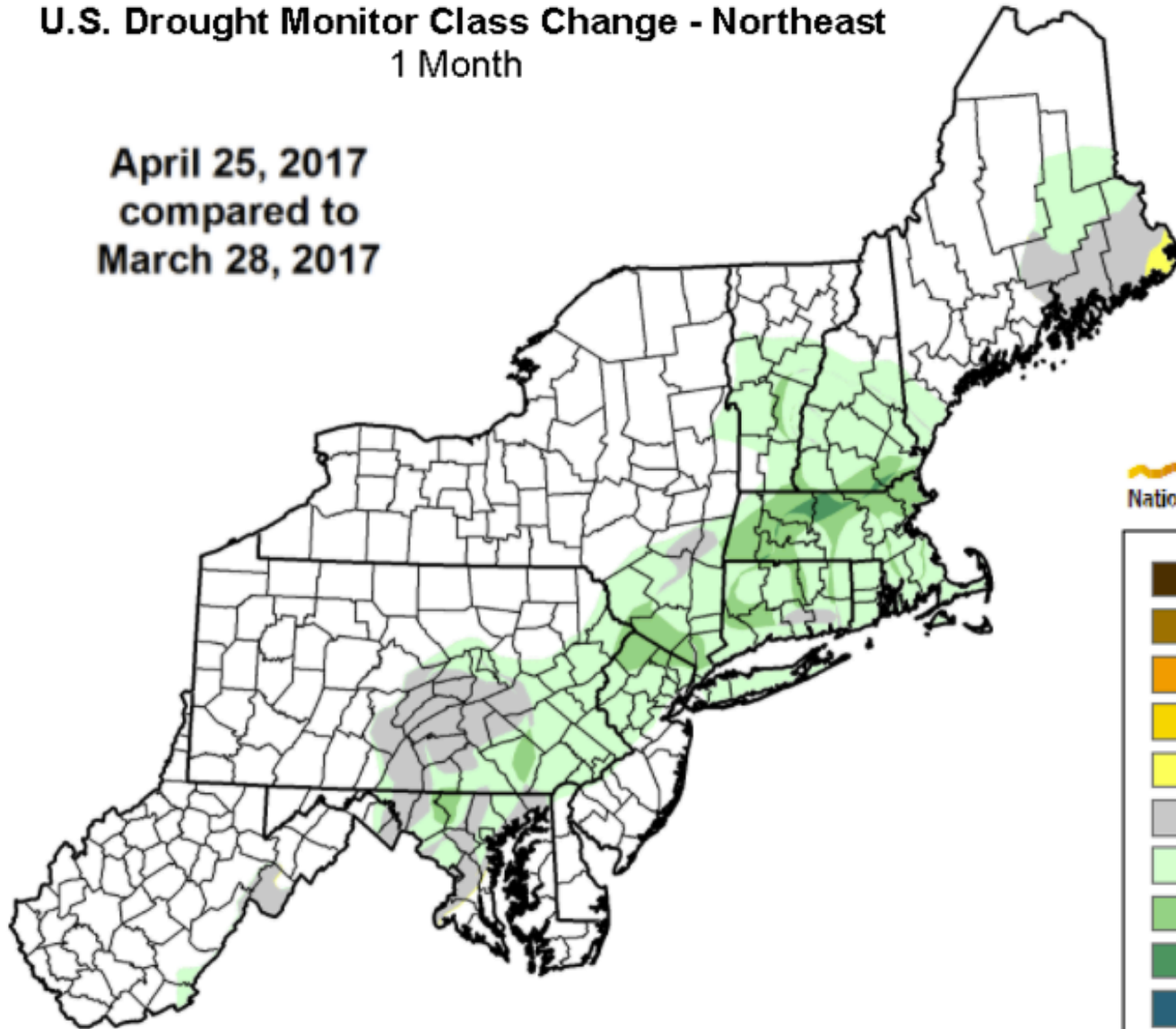




U.S. Drought Monitor Class Change - Northeast 1 Month

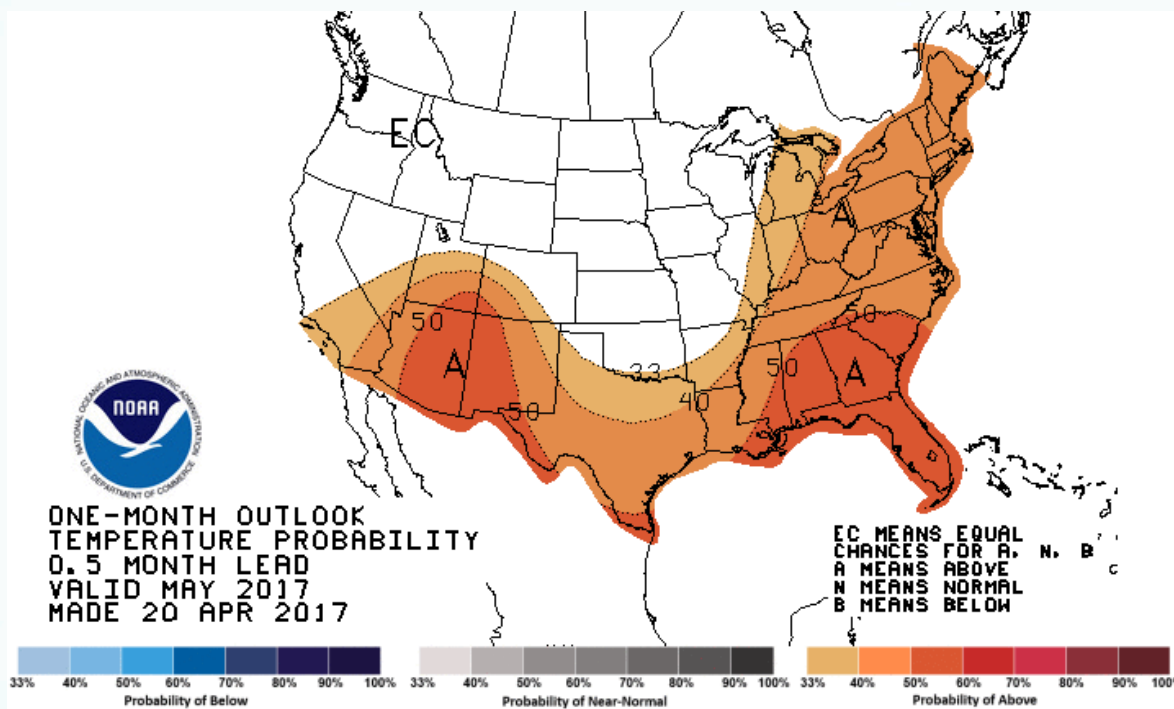

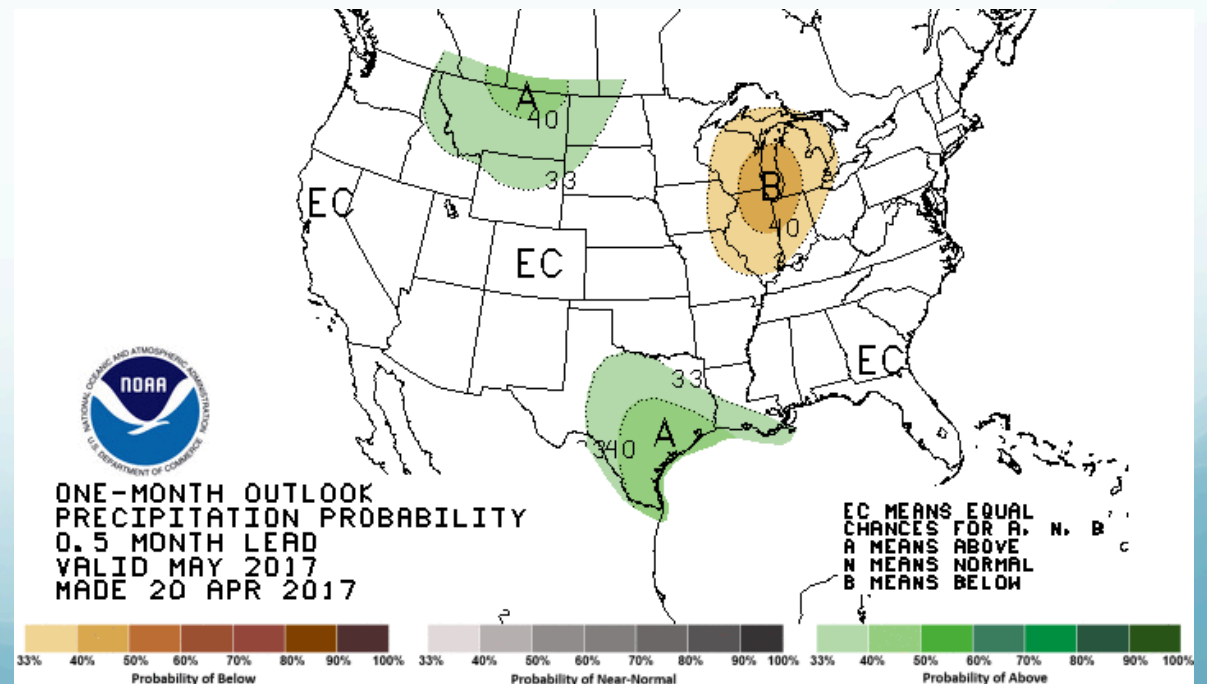
