

Rochester, NY: Sept 24-26


Allentown, PA: Sept 23-25

Williamsport, PA: Set 23-26



# September Temperatures




From 4°F below normal to more than 6°F above normal


#### September Precipitation

8% abnormally dry 5% in moderate drought




D0 Abnormally Dry

D2 Severe Drought


18% abnormally dry 4% in moderate drought
